Last year, the district tried to provide literacy aides for K-3 classes. Unfortunately, most schools got few to none of them. Our school got 1 aid, who split her time between 2 classes, which was great for those classes, but left the other 5 classes with no literacy support. We almost got 2 others earlier in the year, but they were unable to pass the rigorous academic test in order to work with our students. I would like to suggest that the district adjust the test. An aid who is working with K-3rd graders on letters/sounds/early reading concepts should not need to pass a test on 8th grade math. 8th grade math as we all know is very difficult.....and does not have anything to do at all with literacy in the lower elementary grades. We would LOVE to have literacy aides this year.....if possible. Thanks,
