At the Oct. 12, 2023 Board Meeting, the Board:

- Presented a <u>resolution declaring October as National Bullying Prevention Month</u> to Tafoya Elementary School students Donovan Sessions and Natalia Marich and Principal Lyssa Perry
- Approved a <u>resolution declaring Oct. 9 as Indigenous Peoples' Day</u> and highlighted the Board's commitment to begin Board meetings with a land acknowledgment statement.
- Presented a <u>resolution proclaiming October as Domestic Violence Awareness</u>
 <u>Month</u> to Cesar Trejo of Empower Yolo.
- Reviewed a staff report on the <u>California Assessment of Student Performance</u> and <u>Progress (CAASPP) Results</u>. The report highlights our need to continue focusing on strengthening standards-based instruction.
- Reviewed a staff <u>update on the District Data Dashboard</u>. The Dashboard allows users to review schoolwide data.
- Reviewed a staff update on the <u>District Literacy Plan</u>. The presentation reviewed recent student achievement data, outlined current actions to support literacy, and presented the timeline and overview of activities for the development of the literacy plan.
- Reviewed a <u>written School Resource Officer (SRO) Quarterly Report</u>. The report included data on the work our SROs have accomplished this school year.
- Approved a <u>Resolution to Establish Temporary Interfund Transfers of Special or Restricted Fund Monies</u>. This allows temporary borrowing between funds or accounts due to cash flow needs.
