March 30, 2023 Board Meeting Summary

- Trustee Noel Rodriguez presented GATE (Gifted and Talented Education) students with a Board certificate of recognition for their achievement at the Feb. 22 WJUSD Geography Bee (GeoBee) competition. This year's winners were Michael Nichols (3rd place), Charlotte Banuelos (2nd place), and Cash Foldhazi (1st place). Our judges were: Hayden Krause, Bob Folker, and Dennis Silva, with Host Scott Clary.
- Vice President Deborah Bautista Zavala presented 11 Vietnam veterans of Yolo Post 77 with a Board <u>resolution recognizing March 29 as National Vietnam War Veterans Day</u>.
- Trustee Noel Rodriguez presented a Board <u>resolution recognizing March 31 as</u>
 <u>Cesar Estrada Chavez Day</u> to Antonio De Loera-Brust, Communications Director for United Farm Workers.
- The Board reviewed a presentation from Riccardo Gaudino, who shared his
 historical perspective for World Geography Month and for teaching <u>"Sailing</u>
 Around the Horn" Maritime Routes, the Pacific, and Inland Waterways.
- Reviewed a staff report on the <u>proposed annual transportation plan</u>. The Board took no action.
- Reviewed a staff report on <u>Transitional Kindergarten Expansion and Implementation</u>. The state is expanding eligibility for transitional kindergarten and our District has been preparing for the expansion.
- Approved a <u>Literacy Plan Update and Proposal of Services</u>. The presentation included student achievement data and a review of current actions in support of literacy. The research group WestEd will work with our District in the development of a comprehensive needs assessment and literacy plan.

- Approved an <u>agreement for polling and municipal advisory services</u> as part of the decision process as to whether to place a bond measure on the November 2024 ballot.
- Approved the <u>Certification of the Second Interim Financial Report for the Period Ending January 31, 2023</u>. By state law school districts must submit two interim financial reports to their boards. It is the responsibility of a board to certify the financial stability of its district based on these reports.
- Approved an <u>award of construction for the Spring Lake Elementary Playfields</u>
 <u>Project</u>. The Board also voted to agendize a future discussion on the potential expansion of Spring Lake Elementary School.
- Approved Resolution 42-23 Award of Lease-Leaseback Services Agreements to Landmark Construction for the HVAC Project at Woodland High School. As part of an on-going assessment and maintenance program, our District determined that rooftop HVAC equipment on seven buildings at Woodland High School requires replacement.
- Held a public hearing and approved the <u>Initial Proposal for the 2023-2024 School</u>
 Year from the WJUSD Board of Trustees for the Collective Bargaining Agreement
 <u>Between WJUSD and California School Employees Association (CSEA) Chapter #118.</u>
- Scheduled a Board Retreat for Saturday, June 17 to review the <u>Board norms</u> and governance handbook.
- Approved a revised 2023 Board meeting schedule.
