## March 9, 2023 Board Meeting Summary

- Vice President Deborah Bautista Zavala presented <u>Resolution 37-23 in support</u> of <u>Women's History Month</u> to female high school athletes that won championships in their league.
- Trustee Noel Rodriguez presented <u>Resolution 38-23 in support of Arts Education</u> <u>Month</u> to Jose Arenas, Director of Taller Arte del Nuevo Amanecer (TANA).
- Reviewed a staff report on the <u>State and Federal COVID-19 Response Funds</u> <u>Plan</u>. During the pandemic our District received state and federal funds to prepare, prevent, and respond to COVID-19. The original State and Federal COVID-19 Response Funds Plan was approved in 2021 and the updated plan was approved last June. This was a mid-year update for year two of our flexible three-year plan.
- Approved a <u>Summer Youth Advisory StrengthsFinder Camp</u> for students selected for the upcoming Superintendent's Youth Advisory Council. A total of 78 students have applied for 20 available seats on the council and our District will now begin the student selection process.
- Reviewed a proposed <u>Agreement for Polling and Municipal Advisory Services</u>. As part of the decision process as to whether to put a bond measure on the November 2024 ballot, our District hopes to conduct a survey of registered voters. The Board will consider taking action on the proposal at a future meeting.
- Held a public hearing and gave direction to staff to develop an <u>Annual</u> <u>Transportation Service Plan</u> for the Board's review and consideration. School districts can now be reimbursed for 60% of home-to-school transportation costs. School districts must complete a plan by April 1, 2023, or risk losing reimbursement funding.

- Reviewed the <u>Average Daily Attendance (ADA) and Enrollment Report for the</u> <u>2022-23 School Year</u>. The report includes the school site enrollment and Average Daily Attendance (ADA) data for the period of 12/05/22-12/30/22 (Month 7) and 1/02/23-1/27/23 (Month 8).
- Held a public hearing and approved the <u>Initial Proposal for the 2023-2024 School</u> <u>Year Reopener Negotiations from CSEA - Chapter #118 for the Collective</u> <u>Bargaining Agreement Between WJUSD and CSEA</u>. This allows the CSEA contract to be reopened to negotiate safe working conditions and leaves of absence.
- Reviewed an update on the Provisional Appointment Process for Trustee Area 6 Vacancy. The Board extended the deadline for Trustee Area 6 applications to Monday, March 13, by 5 p.m. to allow more time for applicants who may have been affected by potential power outages due to the storm and to encourage additional participation. <u>Click here for the updated timeline.</u>
- Reviewed the <u>New Brown Act Rules Under AB 2449</u>. Included in the new rules, Trustees may attend a Board meeting remotely under certain circumstances, including also allowing constituents to participate in the meeting remotely.
