## May 25, 2023 Board Meeting Summary

At the May 25 Board Meeting, the Board:

- Presented "Student Representatives to the Board" with certificates of recognition for their service, including Jace Williams and Isabella Fernandez from Woodland High School; Liliana Sepulveda and Xochitl Cazares Rodriguez from Pioneer High School; and Exavior Martinez from Cache Creek High School.
- Approved a financial contribution of \$15,000 to the Native American Student Resource Center. Joshina Cluff, Chairperson of the American Indian Parent Committee, shared the history of the development of the committee and the newly established Native American Student Resource Center.
- Approved the Elementary School Plans for Student Achievement (SPSA) for the 2023-2024 Academic Year including <u>Beamer</u>, <u>Dingle</u>, <u>Freeman</u>, <u>Gibson</u>, <u>Maxwell</u>, <u>Plainfield</u>, <u>Prairie</u>, <u>Spring Lake</u>, <u>Tafoya</u>, <u>Whitehead</u>, and <u>Zamora</u>.
- Approved the Secondary School Plans for Student Achievement for the 2023-2024 Academic Year including <u>Douglass Middle School</u>, <u>Lee Middle School</u>, <u>Cache Creek High School</u>, <u>Pioneer High School</u>, and <u>Woodland High School</u>.
- Approved the Kindergarten Through Twelfth Grade Social Science Curriculum Adoption. On May 11, 2023, staff presented an update on the history/social science textbook pilot that teachers and students have engaged in this school year. The Board approved purchasing materials from TCI and McGraw Hill.
- Approved <u>Resolution 54-23</u>: <u>Waive the Community Service Graduation</u>
   <u>Requirements for the 2022 and the 2023 Graduating Students</u>. This waives the
   community service requirement for the graduating classes of 2022 and 2023 and
   resumes the community service requirement for the class of 2024.

- Approved <u>Bid Proposal for Food Service Warehouse Office Construction & HVAC</u>
   <u>Project</u> to increase efficiency and productivity of Child Nutrition Services.
- Approved Resolution 53-23: Approving the Award of Lease-Leaseback Services for the Woodland High School HVAC Replacement Project. A guaranteed maximum price of \$7,564,586 has been established for the project.
- Approved <u>Woodland Joint Unified School District Request for Allowance of Attendance Due to Emergency Conditions</u>. On September 9, 2022, Woodland High School was closed due to dangerous and hazardous temperatures in the classrooms. Education codes state that school districts are to be held harmless from revenue loss that might otherwise result from the loss of average daily attendance (ADA) or instructional time in emergencies.
- Reviewed a <u>New Job Description Coordinator</u>, <u>Community Schools</u>.
- Reviewed a New Job Description Director, Community and Youth Engagement.
- Reviewed an update on the upcoming <u>Board retreat</u> scheduled for Saturday, June 17 at the District Office.
