June 28, 2023 Board Meeting Summary

- Approved the <u>Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP)</u>. The LCAP outlines the actions, metrics, and expenditures that our District has identified to support all four of our LCAP goals:
 - Goal 1: College and Career Ready
 Each student will meet the skills and competencies of the graduate profile in order to be college and career ready through a rigorous, intellectually rich, and culturally relevant environment.
 - Goal 2: Meet Social-Emotional and Academic Needs
 Each student's individual social-emotional and academic needs will be met through quality first instruction, enrichment, and intervention in a safe, supportive, and inclusive environment.

 - Goal 4: Engagement and Leadership Opportunities for Youth
 Provide meaningful engagement and leadership opportunities for youth to directly and significantly shape each student's education and school community.
- Approved the <u>2023 2024 budget</u>.
- Approved <u>Resolution 59-23: Education Protection Account 2023-2024</u>. The State's 2012-13 Budget Act included the Governor's tax initiative, Proposition 30, which led to the creation of the Educational Protection Account (EPA). The

- Approved Resolution 60-23: Sci-Tech Charter School Education Protection
 Account 2023-2024. The State's 2012-13 Budget Act included the Governor's tax initiative, Proposition 30, which led to the creation of the Educational Protection Account (EPA). The EPA's purpose is to receive and disburse funds generated by Proposition 30's temporary tax revenues.
- Approved <u>Declaration of Need of Qualified Educators for 2023-2024</u>.
 This declaration certifies the following:
 - A diligent search to recruit a fully prepared teacher for the assignment(s) was made.
 - If a suitable fully prepared teacher is not available to the school District, the District will make a reasonable effort to recruit based on the priority.
- Approved the Appointment of a Board Ad Hoc Committee to Review Boundaries Study Proposals. On April 27, 2023 the Board directed staff to obtain proposals for a boundaries study. A subcommittee of the Trustees will evaluate and rate proposals, conduct interviews, and make a recommendation to the Board.
