March 14, 2024, Regular Meeting Summary

At the March 14, 2024, Regular Meeting, the Board:

- Approved a <u>Board Resolution in support of Women's History Month</u>. Board Vice President Deborah Bautista Zavala presented the resolution to Maria Olmedo, a Woodland High School alumni, owner of Casa del Pan, and Board Member of the California Association of Bilingual Education (CABE) Woodland.
- Approved a <u>Board Resolution in support of Arts Education Month</u>.
- Reviewed a <u>staff update on our Science Curriculum Pilot</u>. This school year staff and teachers engaged in a piloting process for science curriculum for grades K -12 and will make their recommendations for the curriculum at a future Board meeting.
- Reviewed a <u>staff update on our Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) Program</u>.
 Our GATE program's goal is to provide students with the support needed to meet their academic, intellectual, and social-emotional needs.
- Approved the <u>Certification of the Second Period Interim Financial Report for the Period Ending January 31, 2024</u>. This is the second interim financial report that our District must submit to the Board by state law. The Board must review the interim reports and certify whether or not it believes the District can meet its financial obligations.
- Reviewed a staff report on the <u>Food Services Administrative Review by the California Department of Education (CDE)</u>. The Administrative Review process is designed to ensure that all participating agencies comply with the Federal and State program requirements of the Child Nutrition Programs (CNP).

Approved the <u>First Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding and Joint Use Agreement between WJUSD and Yolo County</u> to build a recreation center on the south end of Sci-Tech Elementary School.
