At the May 23, 2024, Regular Meeting, the Board:

- Recognized Norma Vega, WJUSD Payroll/Benefits Technician, for being selected as the 2024 Classified School Employee of the Year (CSEY) for Yolo County in the Clerical and Administrative Services category. Norma will be honored at the Yolo County Excellence in Education Awards event on Sept. 30 at the Yolo County Office of Education Conference Center.
- Recognized Melanie Graham, RSP Teacher at Whitehead Elementary School, for receiving the 2023-2024 Yolo County Community Advisory Committee (CAC) Award. The committee holds annual awards for community members who have dedicated their time, energy and passion to supporting students with special needs within Yolo County. Graham received an award for her work in the classroom, the school committee, and her efforts to support staff, students, and families.
- Recognized high school student representatives to the Board for their service in representing their schools at Board meetings.
- Approved the Elementary School Plans for Student Achievement for the 2024-2025 academic year, including <u>Beamer</u>, <u>Freeman</u>, <u>Dingle</u>, <u>Gibson</u>, <u>Maxwell</u>, <u>Prairie</u>, <u>Plainfield</u>, <u>Spring Lake</u>, <u>Tafoya</u>, <u>Whitehead</u>, and <u>Zamora</u>.
- Approved a staff report on Secondary School Plans for Student Achievement (SPSA), including <u>Douglass Middle School</u>, <u>Lee Middle School</u>, <u>Cache Creek</u> <u>High School</u>, <u>Pioneer High School</u>, and <u>Woodland High School</u>.
- Approved the New Secondary Course Proposals from the College and Career Articulation Team (CCAT): a. <u>Freshman Seminar</u>, b. <u>Senior Seminar</u>. The Freshman Seminar is a year-long course that supports students in their transition to high school. The Senior Seminar is a 10-credit course that supports students in their transition to life after high school.

- Reviewed a <u>Bond Counsel Presentation</u> on the District's Compliance with the Measure Y Project List. A representative from Jones Hall provided an overview of the legal requirements of placing a general obligation bond measure on the Nov. 5, 2024, ballot.
- Approved a <u>Resolution Ordering an Election</u> to Authorize the Issuance of School Bonds, Establishing Specifications of the Election Order, and Requesting Consolidation with Other Elections Occurring on Nov. 5, 2024.
- Approved a <u>Memorandum of Understanding</u> (MOU) Between Texas Tree
 Foundation and WJUSD to create <u>outdoor learning and play areas</u> at five
 WJUSD schools (Beamer, Dingle, Freeman, Prairie, and Whitehead) as part of
 the <u>Cool Schools Yolo County</u> initiative.
- Reviewed the <u>Average Daily Attendance (ADA) and Enrollment Report for the</u> 2023-24 School Year.
- Approved the Declaration of Need of Qualified Educators for 2024-2025.
