Purpose: a comprehensive program for American Indian or Alaska Native (AI/AN) students that will meet the culturally related academic needs of AI/AN students, including their language and cultural needs

Our projected allocation for 2024-25 = \$4000

### Developing an Indian Education Program: Title VI

Last year's survey on priorities for Indian Education:

- Increase knowledge of cultural identity and awareness
- Increase graduation rate
- Increase career readiness skills (e.g. technology skills, leadership skills)
