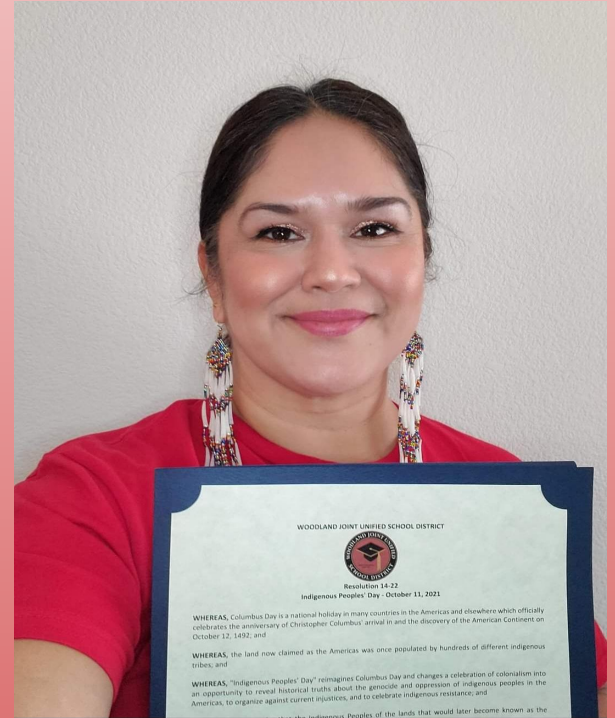

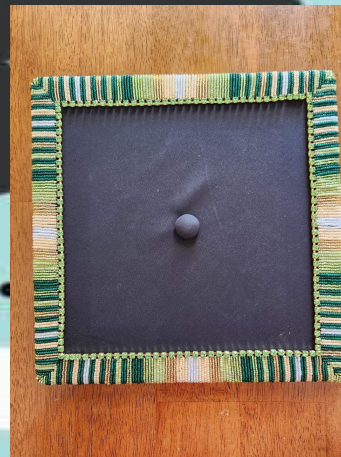

Native Dads Network - IMPACTT Native Youth Leadership Program! (Youth and Adults)
IMPACTT Native youth leadership program is designed to bring "healing and wellness" to Yolo County Native high school students. This 5 week course will bring local tribal presenters to work closely with students building leadership skills, develop cultural knowledge, bring awareness to substance abuse issues and inspire students to be the best version of themselves. Workshops will also promote positive messaging and peer to peer interaction through artistic expressions driven and inspired by local California tribal culture.

High School Senior Project - Mural
The mural project will be an five day H.S. senior project that will be delivered by the Hope Through Art Foundation and hosted by Native Dads Network in Woodland, CA. The seniors participating will create the theme, a vision and assist the artist in painting the mural. Students will have the opportunity to discover their value and voice inspiring hope for future generations.

H.S. Seniors participating in Mural Project MUST attend all Five (5) Native Youth Leadership workshops.

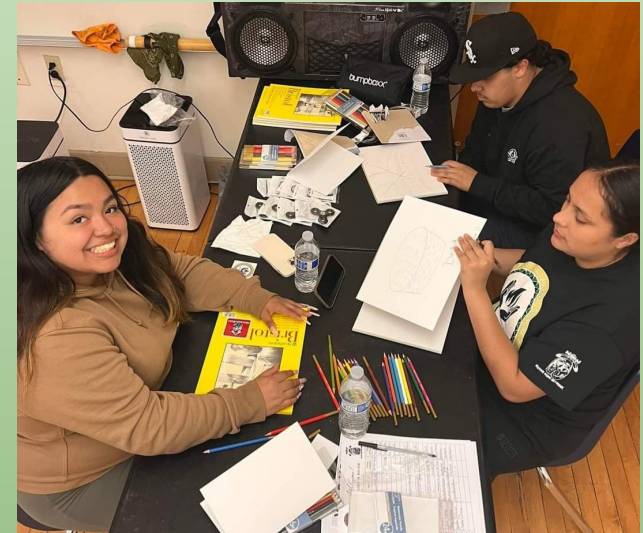
