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1. Welcome
2. Member Topic Request Follow Up: Chronic Absenteeism
  - Information about Chronic Absenteeism was requested by a committee member at an earlier meeting.
  - Dr. Felicia Rodoni-Wilson presented background on truancy and absenteeism. Education Code 48260 defines truancy and E.C.48263.6 defines chronic truancy.
  - Dr. Wilson shared the process that district staff follow to address truancy, from the first truancy notice, to School Attendance Review Board (SARB) hearing, and detailed the criteria for how referrals to SARB are developed.
3. Accountability Update: California School Dashboard
  - Mrs. Lambie presented information about the California School Dashboard, which was released in December 2022.
  - The Dashboard is like a report card for districts and schools and serves as a common set of expectations for district and school performance. The Dashboard is a key part of the LCAP annual review and planning process.
  - The last time the Dashboard was released was in December 2019. Due to the pandemic, the Dashboard was suspended until December 2022, and because of a lack of multiple years of data, the Dashboard looks different this year.

- Only performance is reported this year, not status and change. Also, the College/Career Indicator is not being reported, but some of the data is available.
- The Dashboard is made up of both state and local indicators. The state indicators for 2022 use purple bars to show performance, from “Very Low” to “Very High”. The state indicators reported for 2022 include: Academic Performance, Chronic Absenteeism, English Learner Progress, Graduation Rate, and Suspension Rate.
- Mrs. Lambie reviewed the Dashboard data for each of the indicators, and showed how each student group performed for each of the indicators.

#### 4. LCAP Mid-Year Update

- Mrs. Lambie shared the presentation from the Feb 23 board meeting on the LCAP Mid-Year Update, and highlighted the following data: the number of students achieving industry certification in Career Technical Education, the a-g completion rate, and the data on students who are chronically absent. There is additional data contained in the slides that members can review.
