- Welcome
- Member Topic Request Follow Up: Woodland Youth Plan
 - Loré Carrillo, Director of College and Career, presented an update on the Woodland Youth Plan. She outlined the three phases of plan development.
 - Phase 1 involved creating a Leadership Committee, and then implementing professional development sessions for teams of staff from various city and county organizations. Also, a survey for youth on youth engagement was distributed and the results were collected and analyzed with the Leadership Committee.
 - Phase 2 consisted of Listening Circles with students and parents. The feedback was collected and shared with the Leadership Committee.
 - Phase 3 included a strategic planning series of full day sessions for the teams of staff, which resulted in a drafted plan. The plan will be presented at a special joint meeting of Woodland Joint Unified and the City of Woodland on April 20, 2023, at 5:30 pm, at the Woodland Community and Senior Center.
 - Comments/Questions:
 - Will there be different hubs or will the community center be the main hub for activities; who was the impetus for the Woodland Youth Plan; a lot of kids don't want to be involved in their school; if there were activities, maybe they will participate
- LCAP Development Cycle
 - February Metrics Updates
 - Christina presented the overarching framework for reviewing the LCAP: Given present performance across the state priorities and on indicators in the California School Dashboard, how is the LEA (district) using its budgetary resources to respond to TK–12 student and community needs, and address any performance

gaps, including by meeting its obligation to increase or improve services for foster youth, English learners, and low-income students?

- Christina shared highlights and challenges from each of the four LCAP Goals, and asked for questions from the group. The questions are listed below. Staff will respond to the questions and provide responses before the April LCAP meeting.
 - Comments/Questions for Goal 1:
 - Is there enrollment data for CTE programs, WHS/PHS differences in the data; VAPA - 0 period making it difficult when students have to choose
 - We are failing our students academically; where are our plans?; what are we doing; are there metrics that we're not seeing; talking about dashboard was the only meeting that was an effective action
 - Comments/Questions for Goal 2:
 - Are the teacher credentialing numbers correct? They seem high
 - Are we recruiting; what are we doing to increase staffing?
 - It seems like with goal 2, teachers with experience are not always the best, new teachers are open to learning,
 - About access to instructional materials, we are finding students don't have access who speak other languages, such as Mandarin Chinese; do we get to see how effective the social emotional lessons are?; we have a lot of behavioral issues this year.
 - Comments/Questions for Goal 3:
 - EL is a definitely a bright spot; Eddie at Freeman had different approaches; some worked and some didn't; focus on data
 - it's up to the district to support individual schools to guide them; it does fall on the schools, need to get them the tools they need
 - I don't know if we are seeing an increase in disruptive and violent behavior and if that has an effect on the metrics
 - we're doing very little from PD because we have no time to plan, to digest, to reflect on what we've learned; need to meet as colleagues
 - Comments/Questions for Goal 4:
 - What plans can be shared for implementing the state seal; how we can get educators involved in developing the plans?
- Member Topic Requests
 - Get another update on the Youth Plan; inclusive programs for kids with special needs
 - I would like more data; I know that our students are not where they need to be; I want high effect measures; 7 years ago; I saw the dashboard and then it disappeared;
 - I am curious about percentages/numbers of unfilled classified and certificated positions. Especially in SpEd.
