1. Welcome

2. Introduction to LCAP and LCFF

- The Local Control Funding Formula was established in 2013 and changed the way that school funding was allocated in California
- All schools receive Base Funding, and some schools with high populations of English Learners, low income, and foster/homeless students, receive additional funding
- WJUSD receives base, supplemental, and concentration funding

3. Roles and Responsibilities within LCAP

- The district's responsibilities include consulting with educational partners, identifying student need, developing a plan to support all students, and monitoring and reporting on progress
- Committee members will serve as the liaison between the school site/department/organization, review progress

using data, and provide feedback on the LCAP

#### 4. Accountability Update

- The purpose of the California School Dashboard – to provide parents and educators with meaningful information on school and district progress so they can participate in decisions to improve student learning
- The Dashboard has been suspended for the 2020-21 and 2021-22 school years, but is being relaunched for 2022-23, and is expected to be released in December 2022.
- Schools and Districts will be identified for support using the Dashboard 2022.
