WJUSD School Closures Extended Through May 1, 2020

On March 13, the Woodland Joint Unified School District (WJUSD) announced plans for school closures up to April 20, 2020 to curb the spread of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Today, with extensive consultation and support from the Yolo County Department of Public Health, and the Yolo County Office of Education, WJUSD is extending the period of school closures through Friday, May 1, 2020.

"Our main concern is for the well-being of our students, staff, and families", stated Superintendent Tom Pritchard. "We are a part of our community's efforts to slow the spread of COVID-19 and closing our schools is part of that effort."

All WJUSD schools are taking steps to work with students and families to provide remote instruction. Those steps range from providing prepared packets to launching online instruction programs beginning April 20th. Additionally, WJUSD continues to serve over 3,500 meals daily. Meals will continue to be provided through May 1st from 11am to 1pm at the designated sites.

As always, WJUSD will continue to monitor the latest developments through these very fluid times.
