Morel-reviewed needs assessment and explained that it was the guiding document for reviewing SPSA. Noted that linked document was not updated and linked the correct version. Site leadership reviewed Goal 1. Items highlighted in RED were not applicable to middle school. Site Council focused on Goal 2 with first quality instruction and a safe and supportive learning environment. Described each section. Noted that Goal 2 metrics are based on outdated SBAC scores. MDTP (math assessment) data is new, but ELA and Math indicator from 2019 California Dashboard will not reflect current information. Goals will remain largely the same.  In Math, MDTP noted about a 5% improvement in 7th grade performance. Students were not confident in multiplication and division which is below grade-level expectations. Current 8th graders show declines initially, followed by some improvement but current growth has not matched performance from 7th grade fall MDTP.  As of 3/21/22 we are at 8.2% absenteeism overall.  We would typically used the California Healthy Kids Survey as a metric, but the state has not released the parent version of the text.

Date Posted:

In terms of suspension rate for 2019 we were in 9.8% putting us in the RED category for every subgroup except for EL who were in ORANGE. In the 20-21 school year our rate was .5%. As of 21-22, we are on pace to match the rate from 2019. Although the reasons for suspension this year are more likely to be fights over alcohol related the percentage seems to be consistent.

Some strategies that we would like to implement in the future include more paid time for staff to collaborate and plan to more effectively implement best first instruction. The team opted not to remove any strategies and focus on strengthening current practices. There is a need for planning across departments. There is a need to standardize some amount of classroom practices to remove guess work and provide reliable learning expectations for all students.

R. Rossiter asked that if the collaboration time included in the SPSA allowed us to spend money on it.

T. Morel responded that she included it in Goal 1 so that it would fit a little better.
