Will reduce other sections proportionately. LRC , PD, Supplies, Field trips, Sat School, interventions. We have had to reallocate in order to spend funds. Restrictions occurred due to COVID and Data sets. Our data has not been as robust due to COVID. Our enrollment data has been consistent but our D/F’s have increased.</b></p> <p><b>AB 104 (Serratos/Salcido) “Do no harm for our seniors” (Brown). Allows state requirements to be used. Approx 20-30 kids eligible. Allows Pass/ No Pass grading. Gerald presented student data. 25 kids, and 49 kids could use a credit recovery option.</b></p> <p><b>F’s, 1st semester, 800+/- 4th Trimester 1200+/- therefore need credit recovery options</b>  <b>Q’s “What are the student issues?” Has there been a survey? Online instruction may be an</b></p>
